

General or Anatomic Pathologist

Quinte Health is seeking to fill a full-time Pathology position in the Department of Laboratory Medicine at Belleville General Hospital, starting on or after **January 1**, **2025**.

Candidates must have completed residency training in Pathology and hold certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada. Additionally, candidates must be registered with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario and have Canadian Medical Protective Association coverage.

Quinte Health has an excellent group of pathology assistants and medical laboratory technologists.

Care is provided through four hospitals: Belleville General Hospital, North Hastings Hospital, Prince Edward County Memorial Hospital and Trenton Memorial Hospitals. This includes four emergency departments, operating rooms at three sites, inpatient services (including acute medicine, intensive care, obstetrics, pediatrics, mental health, complex continuing care, rehabilitation and surgery), a rehabilitation day hospital, children's treatment center, ambulatory care clinics, community mental health programs, and a range of diagnostic services.
